Considering the gravity of the current situation because of Coronavirus, Ration distribution was organised at Wazirabad and Budhella in the month of May 2020 with the support of Jesuit Refugee Service. 11 families from Sudanese and Somalis, 79 families from Afghan community and 24 families from Rohingya community benefited from distribution. The distribution was organized in accordance with the social distancing and government protocols and we have taken the support of the community representatives and volunteers who received the training on safety measures.
