

Skill Training Program for Marginalised Women (Poland Project)



This project is a joint initiative of The Embassy of Poland and BOSCO Delhi for the skilling of the marginalized women. It focuses on uplifting and empowering the marginalized women through Job oriented skill trainings. Lot of emphasis is given to the personality development and capacity building of these women to prepare them for the job market.

The first batch of 30 Afghan Refugee women was started in 1st October 2018 and was successfully completed on 31st December 2018 with an 80% placement soon after the completion. The second batch started on 15th July 2019. 31 Indian marginalized women are being trained in two Don Bosco centers.

1. Orane International School of Beauty & Wellness- Malviya Nagar

- 08 women were trained in Beautician Course.
- 06 are employed.

2. La Olive Express- Vikas Puri

- 14 women were trained in Beautician Course.
- 12 are employed.

3. Don Bosco Technical Institute - Okhla

- 08 women were trained in the Graphic Designing.
- 12 are employed.
- 11 women are being trained in the Graphic Designing.

4. Don Bosco Vocational Training Centre, Najafgarh

- 15 women are being trained in the Fashion Designing.
- 05 women are being trained in the Beautician Course
